

Amateur Winemaking Competition Application

Saturday, May 14, 2016

Entry Deadline: April 28, 2016 at 6:00pm

All proceeds benefit the Windber Municipal Authority and the Windber Fire Company No. 1

This is a fundraising event. Proceeds from this event are shared evenly between the Windber Municipal Authority and the Windber Fire Co. No. 1. Both organizations provide countless service to this region, including but not limited to sports and recreational programming and safety of residents of Windber and the surrounding communities.

Competition Rules

- 1. Competition entrants must be at least 21 years of age.
- 2. The competition is only open to amateur winemakers. No submissions are permitted to have been made in a commercial winemaking facility.
- 3. All entries must be in a 750ml bottle with the exception of dessert wines. They may be submitted in 375ml bottles. Please no oddly shaped containers.
- 4. Bottles need to be clearly labeled with the following information:
 - a. Name of Winemaker and Year made (Vintage)
 - b. Specific grapes, fruits, blends, & of each
 - c. Sweetness
- 5. The neck of the bottle must be free of labels, shrink seals, wax or any other identifying markings.
- 6. Wines will be classified by the competition committee and judged with similar wines.
- 7. Ticket purchase to the event (\$20) permits one (1) wine submission into this competition. Each wine submission after that costs \$10. If amateur winemaker is not purchasing a ticket to the event, the first wine submission costs \$15 and each subsequent submission costs \$10.
- 8. Each entry must submit at least one (1) bottle of the wine at the time entry fee is paid.
- All wines, entry forms and fees must be delivered to <u>Windber</u> <u>Community Building</u>. Hours of operation vary so please call ahead to schedule drop off date/time for wines and application. (Call either Jason Zablotney at 814.254.5106 or Angie Maurizio at 814.467.6696 to coordinate drop off date and time.) **Deadline to submit entries:** 6:00pm April 28th, 2016. No refund after a submission is accepted.
- 10. All submissions become property of the WWITP committee.
- 11. Judging will take place between April 30th and May 13th, depending upon the judges' schedule. Judges' decisions are final. Judging will be performed by <u>only</u>American Wine Society Certified judges.NOTE: Neither Windber Municipal Authority staff nor Windber Fire Co. staff participates in the judging of the wines submitted into this amateur winemaking competition.
- 12. The U.C. Davis 20-Point Scoring System will be utilized. Bronze, Silver and Goldmedals will be awarded in each class.Double Gold medals may also be awarded to "Best in Class", such as vinifera, hybrid, Native, blends, fruit, dessert depending upon the number of wines entered in each category.
- 13. Judges score sheets will be available for distribution to the winemakers attending the event; otherwise, score sheets will be mailed to winemakers after the event.
